All course registration must be done **online** (www.moe.gov.sg/jae) through the JAE-IS

1. Access JAE-IS with **SingPass**
2. Strongly encouraged to use the JAE worksheet (www.moe.gov.sg/jaeworksheet) before submitting their online application
3. Strongly advised to make full use of the **12 choices** and **print and retain a copy of Verification Slip** after submission of application.

Bonus Points

Bonus points are given to students in the computation of their net aggregates.

You must first meet the Cut-off-point for the various courses before bonus points is taken into consideration for ranking during posting.

- Students are **strongly encouraged** to indicate at least **2-3 courses** where their aggregate scores are **much better than the previous year's cut-off points (COP)**, so that they will stand a better chance to be admitted to one of their course choices.
- Whilst appeals for a transfer for another JC can be done after the JAE posting results, students should note that their **appeals are not likely to be successful unless they meet the COP of the JC course for that year.**

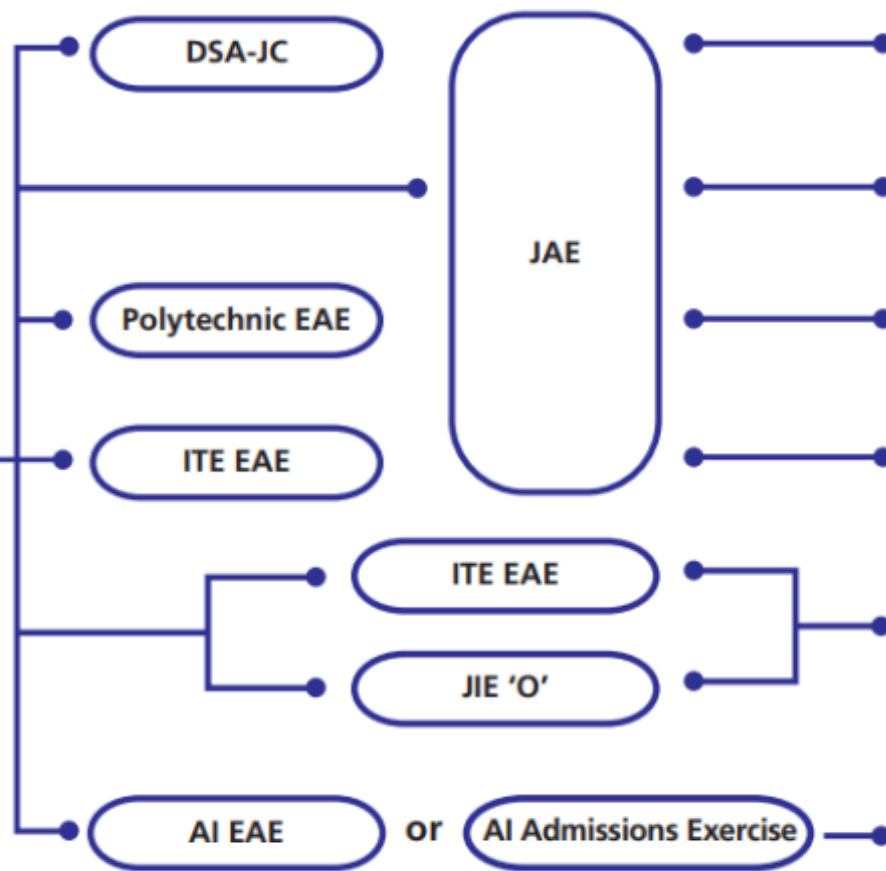

- The DPP posting results will be released at **9 am on
Wednesday 17 January 2025** through the DPP application portal.
- Students will be required to indicate whether they wish to accept or reject the DPP offer **by 11.59 pm on Tuesday, 21 January 2025.**

For successful PFP and/or DPP applicants

- Students who have been offered a place in the DPP under the final application phase should **report to ITE on 22 January 2025** upon acceptance of their DPP course offer.
- The **last day** of school for Secondary 5 students who have accepted a place in the PFP will be on **31 January 2025**. Students will be informed by the respective polytechnics on the enrolment dates for the PFP.
- Students who have accepted a place in the earlier application phase of the DPP in December but decide to take up a PFP offer **now must withdraw from the DPP first before they are able to take up the PFP offer**. DPP-enrolled students should check with their ITE class advisor for more details on the DPP withdrawal process and deadlines for withdrawal
