

#### **Bonus Points**


Bonus points are given to students in the computation of their net aggregates.

You must first meet the Cut-off-point for the various courses before bonus points is taken into consideration for ranking during posting.

- Students are strongly encouraged to indicate at least 2-3
  courses where their aggregate scores are much better
  than the previous year's cut-off points (COP), so that
  they will stand a better chance to be admitted to one of their
  course choices.
- Whilst appeals for a transfer for another JC can be done
  after the JAE posting results, students should note that their
  appeals are not likely to be successful unless they meet
  the COP of the JC course for that year.

#### <u>Direct-Entry-Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP)</u>

- Application for the DPP
   Fri, 10 Jan 2025, 12 am to
   Tue, 14 Jan 2025, 11.59 pm
- The DPP posting results will be released at 9 am on Wednesday 17 January 2025 through the DPP application portal.
- Students will be required to indicate whether they wish to accept or reject the DPP offer by 11.59 pm on Tuesday, 21 January 2025.

## For successful PFP and/or DPP applicants

- Students who have been offered a place in the DPP under the final application phase should report to ITE on 22 January 2025 upon acceptance of their DPP course offer.
- The last day of school for Secondary 5 students who have accepted a place in the PFP will be on 31 January 2025. Students will be informed by the respective polytechnics on the enrolment dates for the PFP.
- Students who have accepted a place in the earlier application phase of the DPP in December but decide to take up a PFP offer now must withdraw from the DPP first before they are able to take up the PFP offer. DPP-enrolled students should check with their ITE class advisor for more details on the DPP withdrawal process and deadlines for withdrawal
