INFORMATION ON CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES (CCA)

We welcome your child/ward to Kent Ridge Secondary School. In our school, we believe that every student matters, and we develop all our students as Leaders of Learning and Leaders of Character.

CCAs in Kent Ridge Secondary School

- 2. As part of character development, CCA is a key student development experience. CCA is a core component of our holistic curriculum where students discover their interests and talents, while learning important life skills. At the secondary level, CCA is compulsory; each student will participate in at least one school-based CCA
- 3. Our school offers 18 CCAs and each CCA offers engaging programmes to build students' character and develop their leadership competencies. You may find out more about the CCAs offered via the URLs provided in the table below.

LEAPS 2.0 Framework

- 4. Our CCA programmes are guided by the LEAPS 2.0 framework to encourage and recognise students' holistic development in life skills, competencies and values. Students will be recognised with levels of attainment in Participation, Achievement, Leadership and Service domains. - 5. At the end of the graduating year, students' CCA attainment can be used for admission to Junior Colleges/Polytechnics/Institute of Technical Education (JC/Poly/ITE).

Choosing A CCA

- 6. We recognise the importance of students participating in a CCA of their strengths, talents and interests. To help students make an informed choice on their CCA, the school is organising the following programme for them to glearn more about the CCAs:
 - i) CCA Fair and Q&A Session [5 January 2024 (Fri), 2.30 to 4.30pm];
 - ii) CCA Trials [held on 15 January 2024 (Mon) and 18 January 2024 (Thurs), 3 6pm]. Your child/ward will have the opportunity to sign-up for 5 different CCA trials with at least one from each CCA group (refer to point 3). A link will be shared through Parents Gateway on 5 January 2024 (Fri). Please complete the sign-up process between 5 10 January 2024 (Wed).

CCA Allocation Exercise

- 7. In ensuring that there are sufficient opportunities for all students to learn and grow in the respective CCAs, the school will need to do a CCA allocation exercise. To help the school make a fair allocation, an online CCA option form will be shared through Parents Gateway on 18 January 2024 (Thurs) after your child/ward has attended the student experiences.
- 8. We encourage all parents/guardians to have a discussion with your child/ward on his/her experience from the CCA trials before choosing the CCA in order of preferences. Please submit this form by **24 January 2024 (Wed)**.

9. Students will receive their CCA allocation by 1 February 2024 (Thurs) and they will commence their first official CCA training session on 5 February 2024 (Mon). As your child/ward will need some time to immerse himself/herself fully into a new CCA, any appeal for change of CCA after the CCA allocation exercise will be considered on a case-by-case basis, subject to availability of school resources and validity of appeals.
